Extremely Loud and Incredible Close – Jonathan Safran Foer

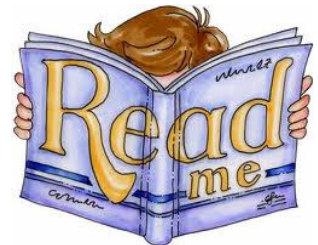
