God's Design for Grandparenting

Deuteronomy 4:9 (NIV):

A spoken blessing has the potential to shape their spiritual journey in remarkable ways, being rooted in their values and Christ-like characteristics, not just in performance and achievements.

Hello and Goodbye: Welcome them with open arms and send them off

with a heartfelt blessing.

Bedtime: End the day with a comforting blessing, reminding them

of God's watchful care.

with a special blessing.

Phone Calls: Even from a distance, your words of blessing hold

tremendous meaning.
